Garbage and Recycling Stations

Garbage Station

The Garbage Station is where you will dispose of your household garbage for pick-up. Each station looks a little different, but is typically a large cage with a door that is located on the side of the road. Please locate the one nearest to your home.

Each station will have the disposal schedule for that area posted on it. The collection day for each type of garbage differs depending on the area. Please confirm the day for each type of garbage, and put it out at the garbage station by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. Please be considerate of other residents and **do not put out garbage on a non-designated day.**



BURNABLE, **NON-BURNABLE**, **HAZARDOUS**, **RECYCLABLE PLASTICS**, Cans/Glass/PET Bottles, and **PAPER** garbage can be disposed of here.

Recycling Station

The Recycling Station is separate from the garbage station, where you can dispose of the listed **recyclable items at any time**:

- Aluminum and Steel Cans
- PET Bottles
- Glass Bottles



- Empty and clean all items before disposal
- Do not put items in a bag
- Separate each item by type into the appropriate labeled bin.

DO NOT throw away **BURNABLE**, **NON-BURNABLE**, **RECYCLABLE PLASTICS** other than PET bottles, and any other non-recyclable garbage away at the Recycling Station.

Garbage Disposal Rules

Only put out garbage on its designated collection day.

How to tie garbage bags



- Long items can be disposed of in the **BURNABLE** or **NON-BURNABLE** garbage bags **IF** most of the item fits into the bag. Tie the bag shut tightly so the object doesn't shift. For example, umbrellas are disposed of as **NON-BURNABLE** garbage.



Large amounts of garbage

You **CANNOT** throw away large amounts of garbage at the garbage station.

If your garbage doesn't fit in the Garbage Station:

- Split up the garbage and wait until the next collection date
- Bring garbage to the Iwa☆Pika Garbage Center P.16
- Call a collection company to pick up your garbage



Rejected garbage

If your garbage is not sorted correctly, the paper on the right will be attached. Collect your garbage and sort it properly before disposing of again.

If the yellow paper is attached and the garbage hasn't been collected, city garbage management staff will contact the owner to warn about proper disposal methods.

- Contains dirty items
 - Remove dirty items
 - Rinse dirty items and put out again
- Contains non-**RECYCLABLE PLASTICS** (no ♻️ mark)
- BURNABLE** garbage – use the official red garbage bag
- NON-BURNABLE** garbage- use the official green garbage bag
- Garbage in a cardboard box cannot be collected
- Branch Disposal Ticket was not attached
- Unsorted garbage cannot be collected

- Vegetables ●Fruits ●Fish
- Egg shells ●Leftovers

Did you know?

About 80% of food waste is actually water. Draining excess water from food waste not only reduces the amount of overall waste, but also bad odors!

- ✧ Peel and remove unusable parts of produce, meat and fish before washing.
- ✧ Leave scraps on a tray to dry.
- ✧ Squeeze any excess water out with a cloth.

→ Soak up excess cooking oil with a paper towel or cloth, and throw away in the **red** garbage bag

→ *Dirty paper items that cannot be recycled*

※ Zippers and buttons do not need to be removed before disposal

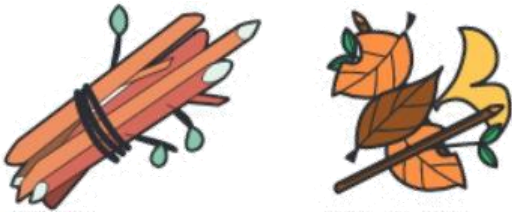

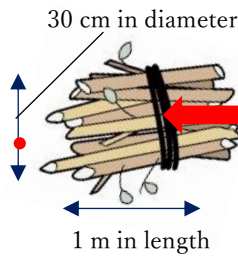
Natural Waste



- Pruned branches
- Fallen leaves
- Grass clippings
- Flowers (soil must be removed)

※ Do not dispose of natural garbage in cardboard boxes or in a non-designated plastic bag

Disposal Ticket for tree branches



Tree branches that do not fit in the official garbage bags must be bundled together and labeled with an ¥80 **branch disposal ticket**.

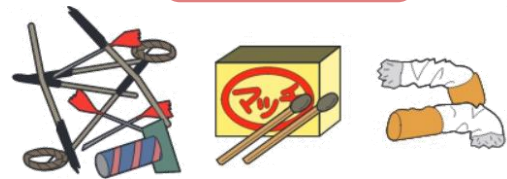
- ※ Branches and tree stumps must be less than 10 cm thick.
- ※ Branch Disposal Tickets cannot be used for processed wood such as timber.
- ※ Items that exceed 1 meter in length are considered **OVERSIZED** garbage.

⚠️ Disposal Rules


- ※ Remove batteries before disposal.
- ※ Wrap sharp items and broken glass or ceramic items in paper or tape to ensure it doesn't tear the garbage bag.



Medical items such as needles that can cause an infection cannot be disposed of with normal garbage. Please return these items to a medical institution.



Plastic medical equipment such as tubes, catheters (with the needle removed), and stoma are **BURNABLE** waste.

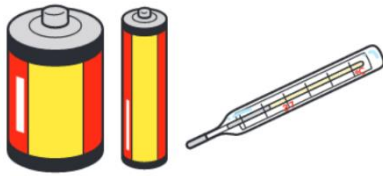
If items have the  symbol, it can be disposed of as **RECYCLABLE PLASTICS** after cleaning.

HAZARDOUS garbage

Collected **1** time/month

Please separate each item by type into any **TRANSPARENT** bag, tie it shut securely, and put it out at the garbage station by **8:30 a.m.** on collection day.

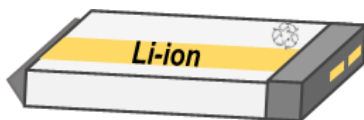
Batteries/Thermometers



- Batteries
- Blood pressure monitors/thermometers that contain mercury
- Wrap lithium batteries (BR or CR type) with tape and dispose of as **NON-BURNABLE** garbage
- Digital thermometers are **NON-BURNABLE**

Rechargeable Batteries

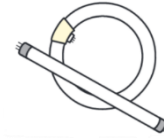
- Other than BR or CR type lithium batteries
- Separate from other batteries



- Be sure to insulate with tape.

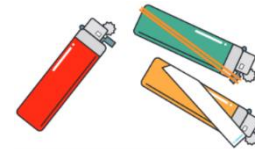


Light Bulbs



- All types are accepted
- ※ You can dispose of lightbulbs in their original box
- Shattered bulbs are **NON-BURNABLE**

Lighters



- Oil lighters
- Gas lighters

Spray Cans



- Spray cans
- Gas cylinders
- Insecticide
- Deodorant spray
- Waterproof spray
- Hairspray

⚠ Empty of all contents lighters and spray cans before disposal.

Please handle lighters and spray cans safely when disposing

Filled spray cans and lighters may start fires inside garbage trucks, and are a danger to the garbage collectors and surrounding citizens.

- ※ Ensure the canister is empty. **DO NOT** puncture the container.
- ※ Empty excess contents in a well-ventilated room, far from fire sources.
- ※ If you can't empty the canister or lighter completely, please write on the bag that it is filled before disposing.

RECYCLABLE PLASTICS

Collected **1** time/week

Please use any **TRANSPARENT** bag, tie it shut securely, and put it out at the garbage station by **8:30 a.m.** on collection day.

What plastics are recyclable?

Not all plastic waste can be recycled, and as such cannot be disposed of as **RECYCLABLE PLASTICS**. Only items with the plastics symbol printed on them can be recycled. All unmarked plastic **must** be disposed of as **BURNABLE**.



Dirty items cannot be recycled!

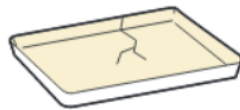
Rinse out all recyclable plastics as well as you can before disposing of. If an item has some irremovable stains or odors it will still be accepted.

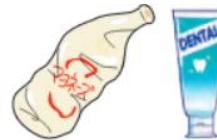

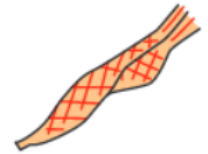

- Bubble wrap
- Styrofoam cooler box

※ Tie together pieces that can't fit in a transparent bag with rope


Other



- Medicine tablet casing
- Plastic caps

※ Any metal pieces are **NON-BURNABLE**
 ※ Aluminum medicine sheets can be disposed as is


RECYCLABLE PLASTICS Disposal Rules:

1. Check item for the  symbol
2. Rinse off dirt and food
3. Remove bottle lids
→ Tightly shut bottles can later cause an explosion during the recycling process. Please remove all lids from bottles.
4. Put everything into one bag
→ Putting many bags into one large bag makes it difficult for the collection company to sort. Please put all plastics into one bag.



Items that are not RECYCLABLE PLASTICS:

Even if it appears to be made of the same plastic material, not all plastic items can be recycled.

When in doubt, look for the  symbol!

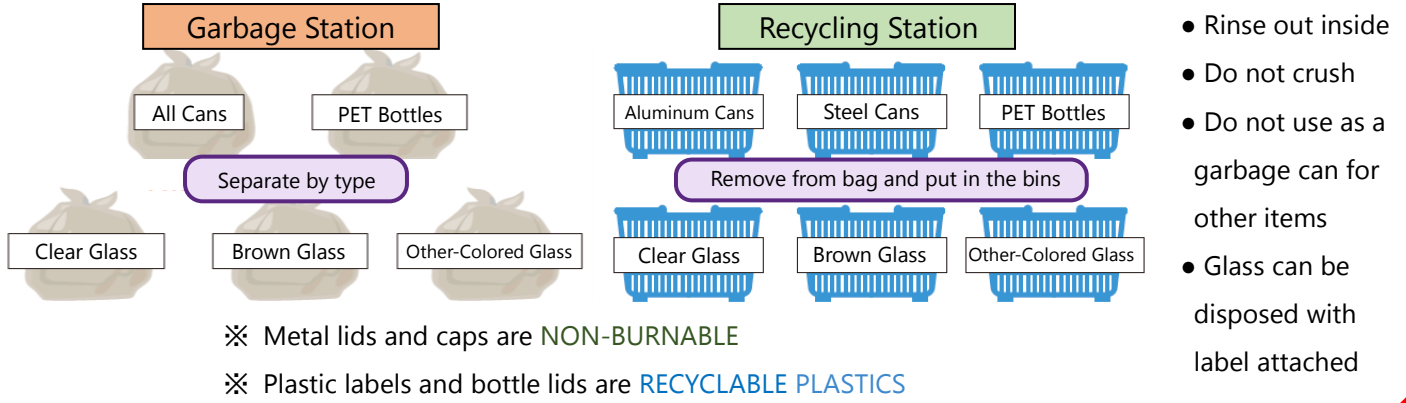

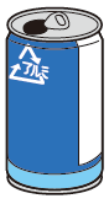

Clear Glass Bottles



- Jam jars
- Juice jars

PET Bottles



- All bottles with the PET symbol on them
- Drink and sauce bottles

Steel Cans



- Look for the  symbol
- Drink cans
 - Food cans

※ Spray paint and grease cans are **NON-BURNABLE**

※ When disposing of at the garbage station, steel and aluminum cans can be disposed of in the same bag.

→ Please separate them at the recycling station

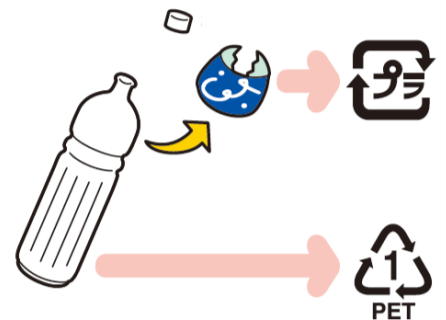

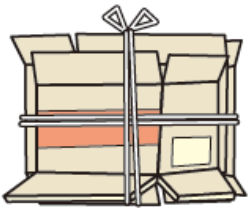

Please separate each paper item by type, tie with string, and put it out at the garbage station by **8:30 a.m.** on collection day.

Flatten and tie with string

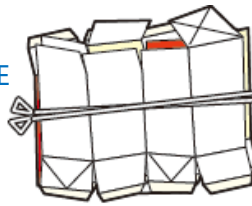

Open, wash, and tie with string

Shredded Paper

Put in a transparent bag



Miscellaneous. Paper

- ▶ Put in any transparent bag
OR
- ▶ Put in any paper bag
OR
- ▶ Tie with string



- Boxes: Food, tissue, plastic wrap, aluminum foil, shoe/cigarette/etc. boxes
- Paper: Leaflets, stationary, business cards, paper bags, postcards, wrapping paper, etc.
- Non-brown rolls: toilet paper, paper towels, wrapping, etc.

※ Please remove any plastic or metal from paper before disposing of



PAPER items that can't be recycled!

- Paper with a lingering smell: detergent boxes or incense stick boxes
- Heat-sensitive paper: receipts, etc.
- Paper with confidential information: bills, bank statements, etc.
- Waterproof paper: paper cups, ice packs, etc.
- Envelopes with adhesive
- Wet or dirty paper items
- Paper with silver or gold foil

If dirty paper items are mixed with recycling, all of those items cannot be recycled. Dispose the above items as **BURNABLE**.

OVERSIZED garbage

10 item limit/month

Oversized garbage that does not fit in a bag must be brought to a *Garbage Center*, **or** you must arrange a pick-up time with an **Oversized Disposal Ticket** attached to the item before disposing at an agreed location.

How to make a reservation

Make a reservation before buying an Oversized Disposal Ticket!

Before you apply, check for:

- Type of garbage
 - Quantity
 - Size (the length of the longest side)
 - Location
 - Please confirm the location and possibility of oversized garbage disposal with your landlord before making an appointment.
 - Apply as soon as possible, collection may take a few days.
- **Garbage cannot be collected from inside your residence, please bring it outside to the agreed location.**

Step 2: Buy an Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket

- You can buy an Oversized Disposal Ticket at any store that sells the city's official **red** and **green** garbage bags.
- One Oversized Disposal Ticket is ¥300. The number of tickets varies depending on the size of the object.



Step 3: Write the Reservation Number and Attach Ticket to Item

- Attach Ticket to the item securely
- Please put item out by 8:30 a.m. at the designated place on the collection day
- Ensure items do not block walkways or roads
- Do not put any garbage or items inside of other items such as wardrobes or dressers

Step 4: Collection

- Garbage will be collected between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. You do not need to be present for collection
- **Items with no Oversized Disposal Ticket, or an insufficient amount of Tickets will NOT be collected**

What is OVERSIZED garbage?

- Items that don't fit in an official 40 liter garbage bag
- Items up to 2 meters in length
- Items up to 100 kg

If the item can fully fit into the **BURNABLE** or **NON-BURNABLE** garbage bags, and the bag can be tied completely shut, it can be disposed of at the garbage station.

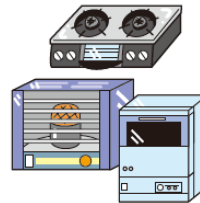

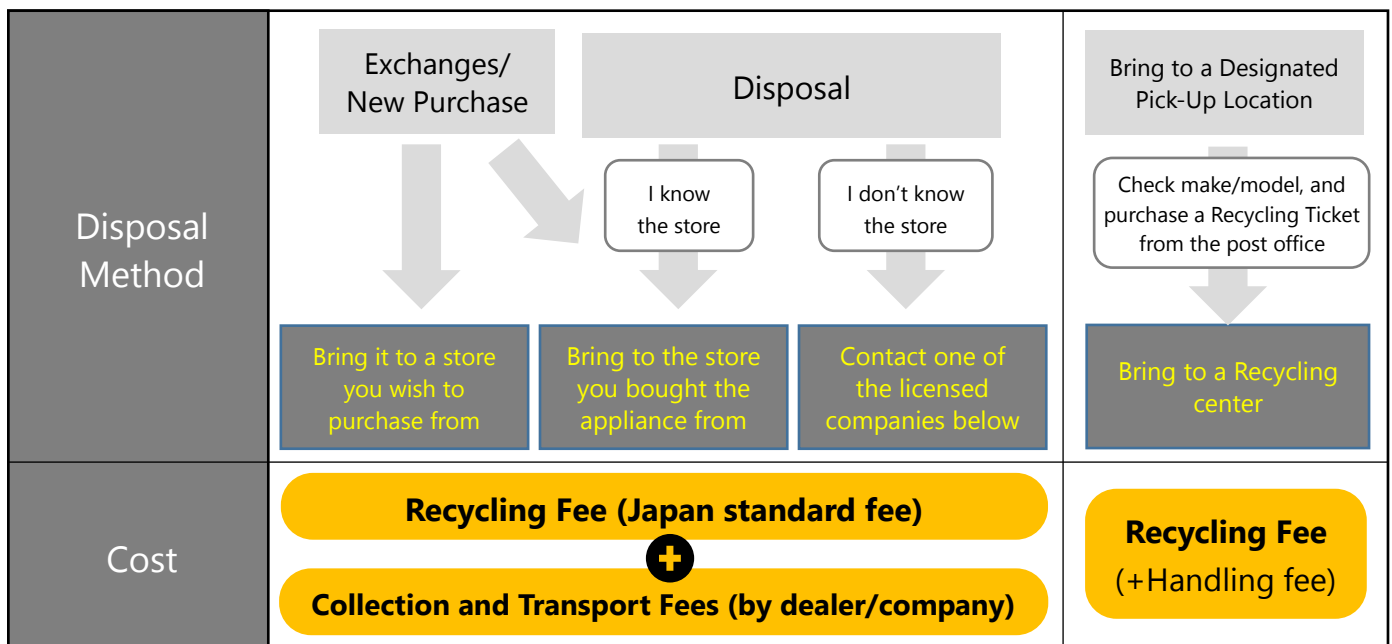
Items that MUST be RECYCLED

How to Recycle Home Appliances

In accordance with the **Home Appliance Recycling Law**, the following items **MUST be recycled** by the manufacturers. You cannot dispose of these items at the garbage station or at garbage centers.

Disassembled parts are not accepted, so please bring the untampered item to recycling.

How to Recycle Computers

In accordance with the Law for the Promotion of Utilization of Recyclable Resources, computers and laptops for at-home use are to be collected and recycled by each manufacturer. In Iwamizawa, old and used computers can be mailed in. You cannot dispose of these items at the garbage station or garbage centers.

How to apply for collection:





1. Apply on the ReNet Japan website
2. Pack the device.
 - The box cannot exceed 140cm and cannot exceed 20 kg.
3. Send application through Sagawa Transport.
 - (Shipping and handling fees may apply)

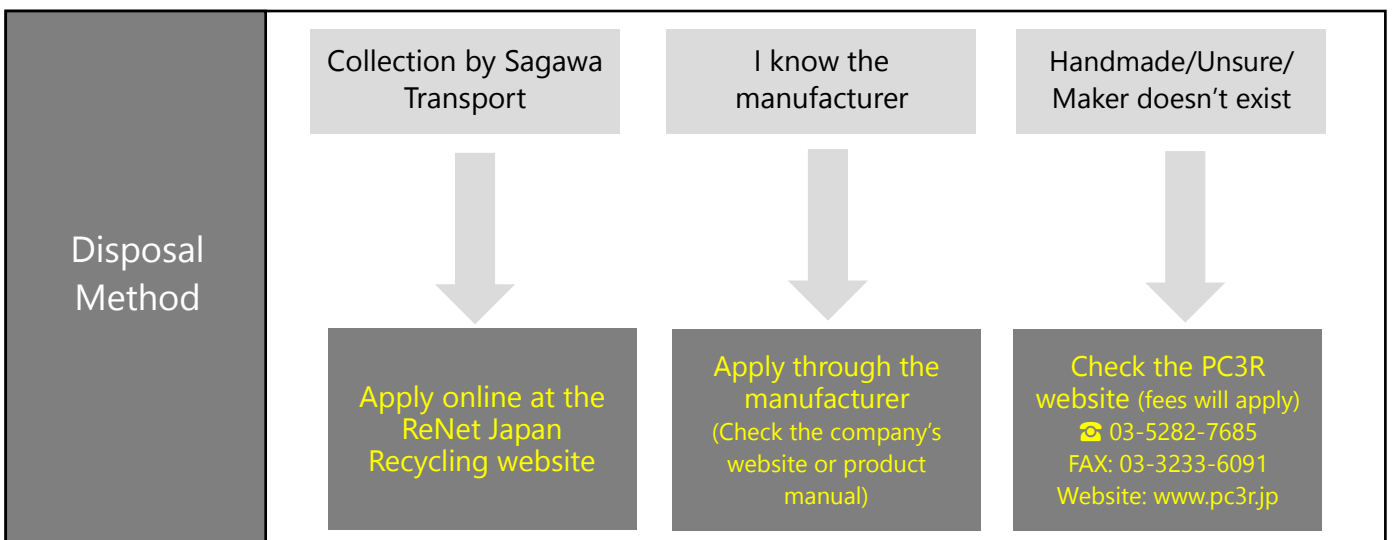

Self-Disposal at a Garbage Center

If you have a lot of garbage, are moving in/out of the city, or cannot wait until the next collection day, you can bring your garbage directly to the Garbage Center.

Transporting other people's garbage without permission from the city is prohibited by law. Only bring your own garbage for disposal. For questions or concerns, contact Iwamizawa City Hall Waste and Recycling Division - 0126-23-4111 (Japanese only)

- When bringing in garbage directly, **DO NOT** use the official red or green garbage bags. Please use a transparent or translucent bag instead.

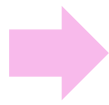

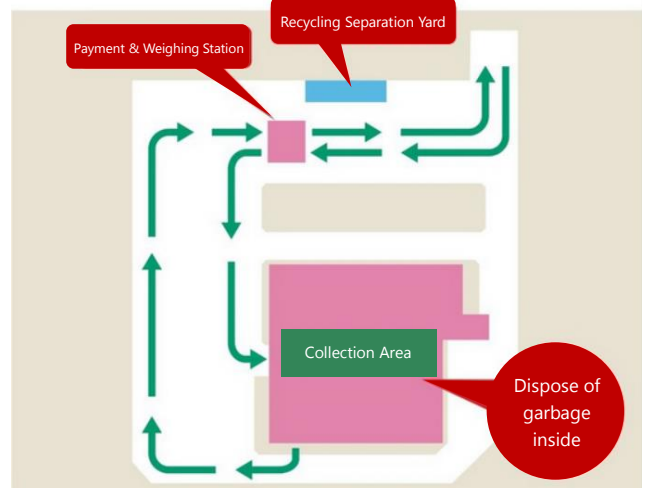
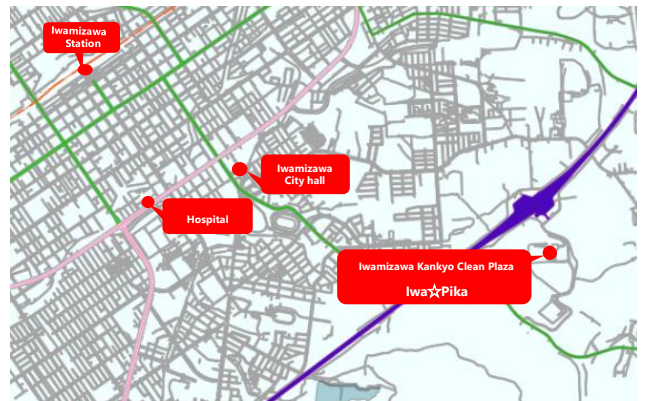

1. Check in at the Weighing Center
2. Weigh your car and check garbage types
3. Unload garbage at the designated location
4. Weigh car again and pay fee
